## Staying Home

Students and staff who are unwell, or have a family member who is feeling sick or who has been overseas in the past 14 days, are asked to remain at home.



## Washing Hands

Frequent hand washing for at least 20 seconds with soap will be strictly enforced at regular intervals throughout the day.



## Temperature Checks

Student and staff temperatures will be measured twice a day. Threshold: 37.5°C



## Wearing Masks

The wearing of face masks *at all times* is mandatory for all students and staff within the school building. We would be grateful if you could please ensure that your child comes to school equipped with a clean mask everyday.



## Classrooms

- Doors and windows open to improve ventilation
- Furniture placement changed
- Students separated by trifold dividers
- Air purifiers in every classroom
- Cleaning kits easily accessible in all spaces



## Emergency Situation

Students and staff with a temperature of 37.5°C or above will be immediately moved to the nurse's room. A pick-up request will then be sent to parents. For confirmed cases of COVID, the ward office will be contacted for guidance.



## Physical Distancing

Students and staff will practice physical distancing (1 ~ 2 meters) at all times.


## Garbage Disposal

Trash will be removed daily. Tissues and similar rubbish should be wrapped in a plastic bag before being thrown out.



## No Sharing

Sharing of food, class materials, etc. is not permitted. All students and teachers should have a personalized pencil case with all necessary items to avoid spreading germs.



## No Visitors

All visitors are kindly requested to avoid entering the school building, unless urgent.




## Scheduling

In order to safely follow our physical distancing guidelines, opt-in students have been grouped into cohorts and assigned days to come to school.



## Lunch

Students should bring lunch from home and avoid using the kitchen, school utensils, glasses, etc. Trifold dividers will continue to be used during lunch, with talking kept at a minimum.



## Cleaning Kits

All staff will carry around a personalized cleaning kit, equipped with hand sanitizer, face masks, and other health implements.



## School Cleaning

The school space will be professionally cleaned before reopening. Regular cleaning will occur several times a day by staff, focusing on frequently touched surfaces such as doorknobs, tables, chairs, and so on. Heavy duty cleaning supplies, such as bleach solution, will be used to ensure proper disinfection.
